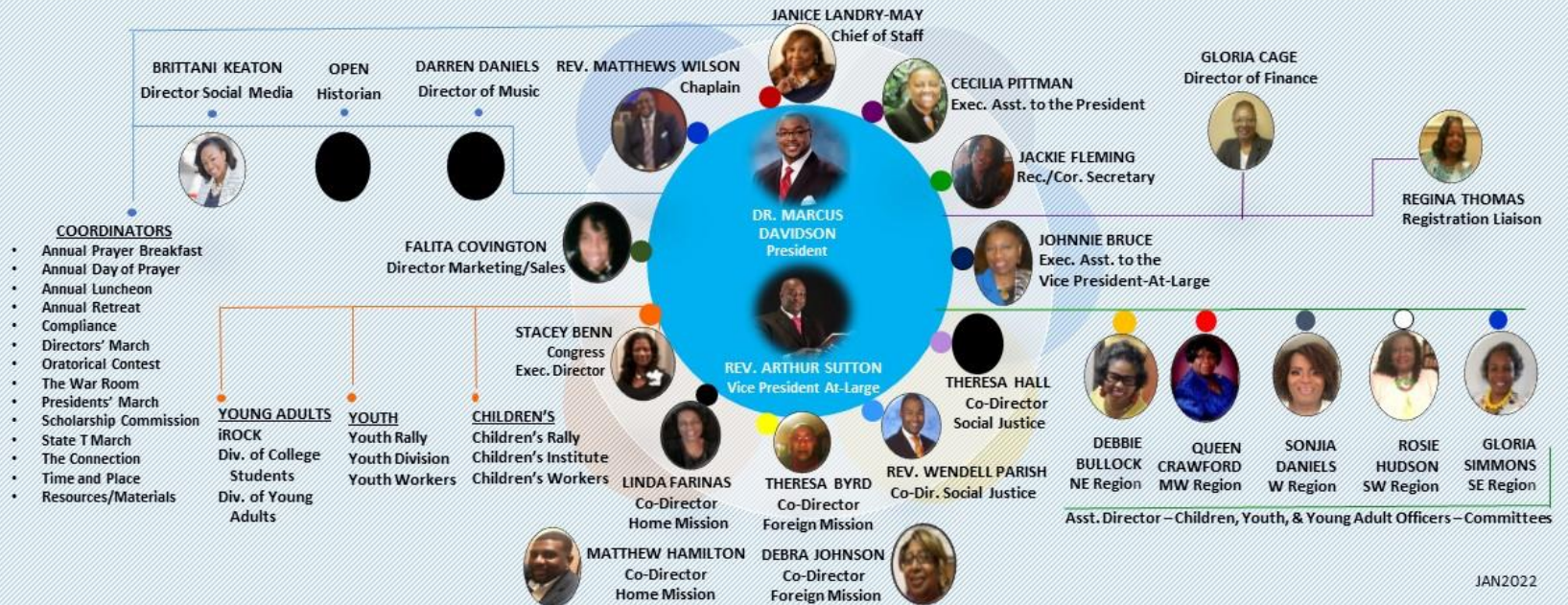

It was not until two years later because of Covid-19, via Zoom, that the Youth and Young Adult Auxiliary was fully implemented.

Our purpose is to teach and empower children, youth and young adults to engage in Christian service in their church, communities, and global village.

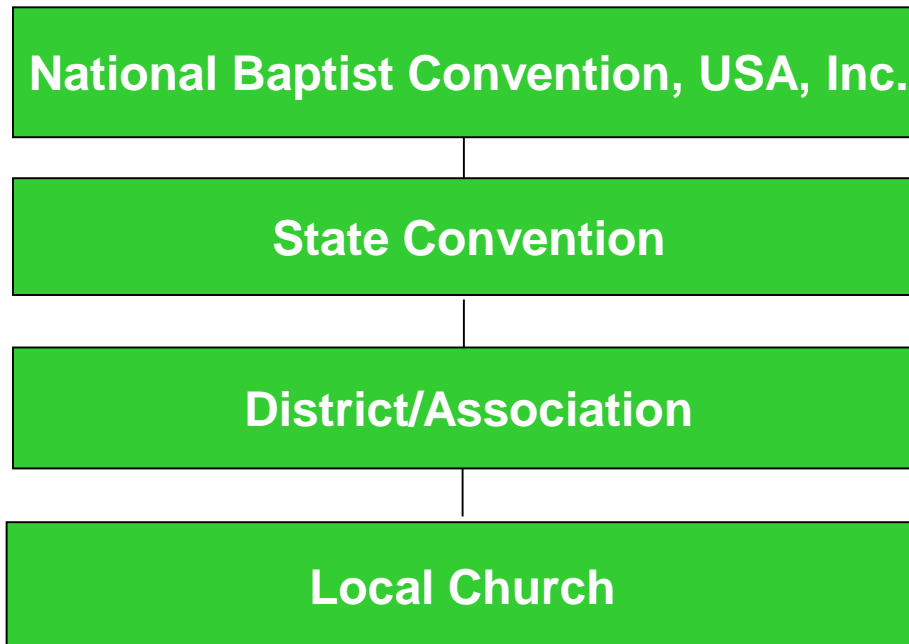
Our overall objective is to develop a holistic, inclusive ministry that meets the needs of our young people of all ages.

Sample Job Descriptions

President

The primary duty of the President is to lead by following Christ's example and fulfilling the mission/vision of the organization. The President at all levels should endeavor to be a servant leader. The President appoints officers; moderate meetings; attends annual and board meetings; maintains an environment where new members are enthusiastically welcomed, trained, engaged and respected; actively encouraging leadership development in members; and at all times conducting oneself in a manner which protects and enhances the reputation of the organization. The President shall reports to:

Sample Job Descriptions

Vice-President At-Large

The Vice-President At-Large may be called upon to serve in place of the President as needed. He/she may chair meetings and may be called upon to represent the organization at special functions. He/she should attend Annual and Board Meetings within the Convention and moderate meetings when called upon by the President. The Vice President supports the mission and ministry purpose and aim; establishing and implementing it across the world, while also providing supervision and support to staff; serving as a strong liaison between domestic and international programs; and managing the overall finances and sustainability of said organization. The Vice President- at-Large is an executive level position and as such will report directly to the President. He/she will provide support as needed to the Regional Vice-Presidents and all other executive level staff.

Sample Job Descriptions

Regional Vice-Presidents/Directors

Regional Vice-Presidents and/or Directors/Coordinators will give leadership to the respective age demographics working under the rubric of one common mission vision with goals, which have been established by the President. Also, if there are regional meetings, those meeting will be led and organized by the Regional Director/Coordinators upon approval of President or his designee. The Regional Vice-Presidents/Directors reports to the Vice President-At-Large.

Sample Job Descriptions

Congress Director

The Children, Youth and Young Adult Executive Director of Christian Education serves as the central figure ensuring the quality, substance, and appropriateness of the Christian theology taught that serves an integral part in the Convention's mission and vision. He/she should demonstrate an ability to have a good working relationship with the president, staff and members, and have proven experience in leading children, youth and young adults in an ecumenical Christian Conventions. He/she should have a commitment to the Christian faith in an ecumenical environment • Enthusiasm and optimism about education ministry to youth and children and their families • Ability to work with youth and children and concern for their nurturing as persons and as disciples of Jesus Christ • Strong listening skills and sincere interest in others • Understanding of development of children, Pre-K through teens • Strong verbal and communication skills • Ability to educate and communicate to families of children and youth • Ability to recruit, coordinate, train and supervise volunteers • Self-starter with a strong commitment to excellence • Team-player with a "can do" yet flexible attitude • Excellent organizational and administrative skills; strong attention to detail. Reports to the Vice-President-At-Large.
